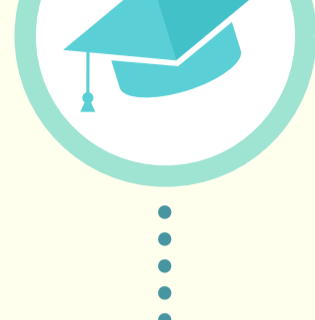

That's why we want to make the transition from SAC student associate to SAC member as simple as possible.

HERE'S A QUICK FAQ TO HELP GET YOU STARTED.

**Q:** I just graduated, how do I go from being an SAC student associate to an SAC member?



The important thing to keep in mind is that your status as an SAC student associate is still active until the end of December. We'll be contacting you in late October to renew as an SAC member.

**Q:** What will I need to do to renew as an SAC member?

send us official transcripts, indicating proof of graduation/master's degree conferred and signed proof of having completed 300 clinical practicum hours.

No documentation required. We'll look you up in your regulatory body's online registry to confirm your status with them.

or have your regulatory body send us a letter of good standing. You can find their contact info on the SAC website.

**Q:** I need professional liability insurance (PLI). How do I get the new grad discount?
