

Application Package — Speech-Language & Audiology Canada Awards Program 2018

- Award:** Isabel Richard Student Paper Award (below doctoral)
Deadline: December 1, 2017
Objective: To recognize an SAC student associate enrolled in an S-LP or audiology program below the doctoral level for the best paper written on a specific topic related to the professions. Essays shall be **1,000-1,500 words** in length (not including references) and submitted typed, double spaced. *If you choose to include citations and references, you must follow APA style.* Judges will assess papers on both style and content and will look for writing that is clear, articulate and logically organized. Content should be factually accurate and ideas/opinions expressed in the paper should be original and innovative. **The winner will receive a \$1,500 cash prize and a complimentary continuing education voucher for use towards SAC's professional development opportunities. We will also publish the winning paper in *Communiqué*.**

Nomination Tips:

- 1. Plan Ahead**
Start preparing your submission well before the deadline – the more time you leave yourself, the better! Select your topic early on. Take care in writing your paper and be sure to follow all instructions.
- 2. Know What's Expected**
Your paper will be evaluated on content, writing style and format. A good paper considers a subject thoroughly from more than one perspective, shows originality and stays on topic. Provide support for your points where appropriate. Your writing should be clear, logical and easy to understand. Avoid repeating yourself. Stay within the word limit and be sure to review your work for grammatical, spelling and typographical errors.
- 3. Submit on Time**
You can send in your nomination package by email, regular mail or fax by December 1, 2017.
- 4. Persevere**
If your submission is not successful this year, apply again! You can ask the SAC Awards and Recognition Committee for comments and feedback from your evaluation so you know what to improve on before you re-submit. You can also request that your submission package be returned if you need the information to re-apply.

Eligibility Criteria for This Award:

To be eligible for this award, nominees:

- Must be an SAC student associate (students registered with SAC as a non-student member are eligible if they can provide proof of enrolment).
- Must be enrolled in an S-LP or audiology program below the doctoral level.
- Must stay within the word limit (1,000-1,500 words); judges will only consider submissions that follow the instructions for length and format. Students are encouraged to back up their opinions with appropriate literature.
