Peer Nomination Form

Awarded to an SAC student associate, in their graduating year of Master's study, in each of the communication disorders (speech-language pathology and audiology) university programs in Canada, who is determined to be the best all-round future professional. Winners will receive a complimentary continuing education voucher for use towards SAC's professional development opportunities.

Selection is based on a peer nomination process with student recommendations forwarded to Student Representatives. Names of the three most nominated individuals are presented to university faculty advisors, who are responsible for choosing the final winner based on clinical ratings, leadership qualities and grade point average. One faculty advisor must sign and submit a nomination form for each student which contains sufficient documentation to confirm the candidate's qualifications and clinical grades (official transcripts are not required), as well as a copy of the student's curriculum vitae.
