

<b>NOMINATIONS COMMITTEE</b>	
<b>Vacancy</b>	There are three (3) vacancies on this committee.
<b>Qualifications for Vacancies</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• You must be a practicing speech-language pathologist or audiologist.</li> <li>• You must be a Speech-Language &amp; Audiology Canada (SAC) member.</li> <li>• Current SAC Directors are not eligible for appointment to the committee.</li> </ul>
<b>Mandate</b>	<p>The mandate of the Nominations Committee is to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• draw on the experience of Speech-Language &amp; Audiology Canada members to ensure the association has the highest quality of elected leadership founded on Speech-Language &amp; Audiology Canada’s competency-based model;</li> <li>• evaluate the Board and examine the skills and characteristics needed in Board and Committee candidates;</li> <li>• identify suitable candidates for various Director positions and recommend a slate of nominees for the Board positions being elected in any given year;</li> <li>• identify suitable candidates for SAC Standing committees; and</li> <li>• recommend amendments to nominations policies and procedures for SAC Board consideration.</li> </ul>
<b>Length of Term</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Members of the Nominations Committee shall serve a three-year term and may be reappointed for a maximum of a second three-year term (maximum six years).</li> </ul>
<b>Time Commitment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Nominations Committee meets six to eight times a year.</li> </ul>
