Qualifications for Vacancies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You must be a practicing Speech-Language & Audiology Canada (SAC) member. • You must maintain your SAC membership throughout your term.
Mandate	<p>The mandate of the Scholarship Committee is to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • recommend the criteria for scholarships to be awarded to students in all professions by the associations; • write the application forms; • define the procedure for the scholarship selection process; • select scholarship recipients; • evaluate the selection process and outcome.
Membership	<p>The Scholarship Committee shall be composed of a minimum of eight and a maximum of 12 practicing SAC members, one of which shall serve as committee Chair. Committee members must maintain SAC membership throughout their terms.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A minimum of one individual must be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ an audiologist; ○ a speech-language pathologist. • A minimum of two individuals must be fluently bilingual. • Interested funding partners may have a representative on the committee (non-voting). • Permanent members not included in the minimum or maximum number of committee members are the Chief Operating Officer and other designated staff. Staff liaisons are non-voting members.
Length of Term	Members of the Scholarship Committee shall serve a four year term and may be reappointed for an additional four year term (maximum eight years).
Time Commitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approximately 15 hours throughout the application and evaluation cycle (done electronically between mid-October to February). • One teleconference meeting at SAC's expense. • Preparation work may be required in the spring before the scholarship program is promoted, estimated at five hours.
