Mandate	<p>The mandate of the Clinical Research Grants Committee is to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • recommend to the Board the criteria for the clinical research grants to be awarded by the association; • write the content for the clinical research grants application forms; • define the procedure for the grant selection process; • select grant recipients; • evaluate the process and outcome.
Length of Term	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Members of the committee shall serve a three-year term and may be reappointed for an additional three year term (maximum six years).
Time Commitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3-4 teleconferences/video conference of 1 hour each/year (including one in the fall and one in mid- to late-June to adjudicate the submissions). • Approximately 4-6 hours in early June to review the submissions/applications (depending on the number of submissions received).
