As part of our ongoing commitment to support student associates in their pursuit of becoming communication health assistants, SAC's Board of Directors has established an annual scholarship valued at \$750.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

Applicant is evaluated on:

- Academic transcript
- Academic reference
- Essay (including key items listed on the essay topic sheet)

Applicant must be a:

- Canadian citizen or permanent resident of Canada.
- SAC communication health assistant student associate.
- Full-time student enrolled in a formal educational program for communication health assistants.

Applicant must submit:

- Academic transcript (digital copies are accepted*). For those in a one-year program, please provide transcript for first semester.

**SAC holds the right to request an official transcript if deemed necessary*

- One academic reference (using the form provided in the application package). The academic reference form must be emailed directly from your reference to membership@sac-oac.ca.
- A short essay (max 800 words) about:
 - › your interest in the field of communication disorders.

- › your personal strengths that will be brought to this career path.
- › your volunteer work accomplished in any field. Please indicate if the volunteer work was related to communication disorders. (for more details on the essay, [click here](#).)

General information:

- Applicants will be notified by email of recipient status.
- Please notify SAC of any changes to the email address given on the application form.
- Proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent resident status and a social insurance number (for a T4 to be issued) must be provided upon request.
- The recipient's name, university or college and province or territory may be used in SAC publications.
- All scholarship recipients will receive T4A's which will be sent out in 2021.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How much is the scholarship worth? **\$750.**
2. When is the deadline to apply? **February 1, 2021.**
3. Is it okay to include the reference evaluation forms in my package? **No. The forms must be emailed by the reference person directly to membership@sac-oac.ca.**
4. Can I submit a photocopy or scanned version of my official transcripts? **Yes. Digital copies will be accepted but SAC holds the right to request a physical official transcript if deemed necessary.**
5. Will my application be accepted if it is postmarked by February 1? **No. The SAC office must receive your completed application package no later than February 1, 2021.**
6. When will it be awarded? **Spring 2021.**
