| Length of Term | Members of the Scholarship Committee shall serve a four-year term and may be reappointed for an additional four-year term (maximum eight years). |
| Time Commitment | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Approximately 15 hours throughout the application and evaluation cycles (done electronically between mid-October to February). • Two to three vitrual meeting at SAC's expense. • Preparation work may be required in the spring before the scholarship program is promoted, estimated at five hours. |
