About the Program

Speech-Language & Audiology Canada's Mentorship Program (formerly known as the Career Development Program, or CDP) is a program that connects students and new graduates with speech-language pathologists and audiologists who have been working in their respective professions for a number of years. The program is designed to help new and soon-to-be-new professionals navigate the opportunities and challenges they face at the beginning of their career.

Mentees will take the lead in the partnership to gain a better understanding of the professional world, expand their network and identify areas for personal and professional development. Mentors, in supporting their mentees, will have the opportunity to earn CEE credits, give back to their profession, make new contacts, learn about new trends and enhance their leadership, communication and management skills.
